The exact number will largely depend on star Laurie Metcalf's schedule. TVLine reports that an insider revealed that the show was able to increase their number of episodes after Metcalf and co-star Sara Gilbert made changes to their schedule. Gilbert just announced last month that he will be leaving his talk show, The Talk, to focus on other projects. The entire main cast will return for Season 2. This includes John Goodman, Sara Gilbert, Metcalf, Lecy Goranson and Ames McNamara. All the stars reportedly received a substantial pay rise to return to the show. Will Johnny Galecki return full-time to 'The Conners'? Now that The Big Bang Theory has ended its 12-year run, many fans wonder if this means former Roseanne star Johnny Galecki will be back full-time. Galecki played David Healy from 1992 to 1997. His character married (and later divorced) Darlene Conner and was very popular with fans. Since the Conners first appeared, Galecki has appeared in a limited function, appearing in an episode of Roseanne's reboot and two episodes of The Conners. Asked if a return to the show was on the cards, Galecki told TVLine that he would love to return to his recurring role. Although she loves the show and the cast, she says she needs some time off from being on a full-time show. Dexter is destroyed by this revelation, but ends up having a closer relationship with Debra, who has lived with him for several months because she can sleep alone after discovering that The Ice Truck Killer was her boyfriend.
